Highlights of the “V-Days” celebration will include neighborhood canvassing, mobile vaccine units, a 42-hour vaccinathon, and entertainment from Toledo Symphony musicians at one vaccine pod! **COMMUNITY CARES CLINIC PROVIDES 42-HOUR VACCINATION!** In conjunction with the Toledo Lucas County Health Department and other community partners, Dr. Richard Paat will hold a 42-hour **vaccinathon** from 6 PM Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup> to Noon on Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at the Smart Academy School at 617 Western Avenue in Toledo. The one-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be administered—no 2<sup>nd</sup> appointment will be necessary. Walk-ins are welcome (perfect for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> shift workers), and you may also make an appointment by calling 419-318-2191.
